

KNCB Code of Conduct

Players:

- Always be positive and sportsman like in all things that you post on social media.
- Respects the rights, values, faith and cultures of all the players, spectators and officials at all times.
- Have a good understanding of the rules and regulations that are relevant to the game you are playing.
- Respect the decisions made by the officials, coaches and team leaders even when you may not agree.
- Always be positive and show good sportsmanship when talking to team mates, opposition players, coaches and team leaders.
- Listen to your coach as they are only trying to help you develop as a player.
- Always be honest towards your coach, officials and team leaders. Some key areas are injuries and talent development.
- Ensure you work hard (at school and sport), keep up your part of any agreement, take responsibility for yourself, always answer any question to the best of your knowledge and always stay engaged.
- Ensure the playing/spectator area is cleaned up and all litter and the like is cleared up. Always respect the facilities that are being provided like nets and tables etc.

Parents and Guardians:

- Always be positive and sportsman like in all things that you post on social media.

- Always be positive in your encouragement of your child playing sport. The emphasis should be on the fact that they are participating and not on the result of the game.
- Always remain grounded in your expectations and respect the advice/decision of the coaches. They are there to help your child develop.

- Acknowledge all performances, even those of the opposition. This is good sporting behavior and again your child will follow your example.
- Allow your child the opportunity to enjoy being around the team and interact with team mates. Encourage your child to take responsibility of their role within the team dynamic.
- Ensure the playing/spectator area is cleaned up and all litter and the like is cleared up. Always respect the facilities that are being provided like chairs and tables etc.
- Respect the agreements regarding costs for the sporting development of your child.
- Ensure you answer all questions to the best of your knowledge and always stay engaged.
- Remember that you are setting the example for all the children in everything you do.
